



What is Financial Peace University (FPU)?

We all need a plan for our money. Financial Peace University is that plan! It teaches God's ways of handling money. Through video teaching, class discussions, and interactive small-group activities, FPU presents biblical, practical steps to get from where you are to where you've dreamed you could be. FPU shows you how to get rid of debt, manage your money, spend and save wisely, and much more. FPU classes meet for around an hour and a half each week for nine weeks.

What is FPU membership?

When you purchase an FPU membership, you receive all the class materials and access to the FPU online resources you need to succeed. Your membership means that you can attend the FPU class as often as you like. Spouses and engaged couples can attend together with a single membership, and teens living at home are welcome to attend with their parents.

What does it cost?

Your FPU membership costs \$93 plus shipping and includes all the class materials and FPU online resources used during the course. This lifetime membership fee allows you to repeat the course as many times as you like at any location. This is helpful when you find yourself at a different age or stage in the future and could benefit from a repeat. No portion of this fee goes to St. Mary's or to the coordinator.

When is the deadline to register?

To ensure that you receive your materials in time for the first class, you should register and purchase them using the link below by Friday, August 26. If you order later than that, it is possible to print out materials to use for Lesson 1.

How is each class structured?

Each class session lasts approximately an hour and a half. During the first hour of class, Dave Ramsey teaches on DVD. Participants come together during the last part of each class for a small-group discussion and hands-on activities. You may share as much or as little as you feel comfortable. Group members support and encourage one another as they work to change their financial futures. Each week you will also have at-home activities designed to help you think about and act on your personal financial plan and goals.

What happens if I miss a class? Can I make it up?

As part of your membership to FPU, you'll receive audio discs of all nine lessons. If you miss a class, you can review that week's lesson on CD and share what stuck out to you with your coordinator when you return the following week. Videos of each lesson are also available in FPU Central.
